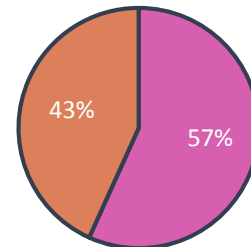


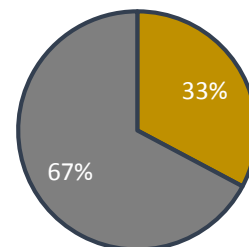

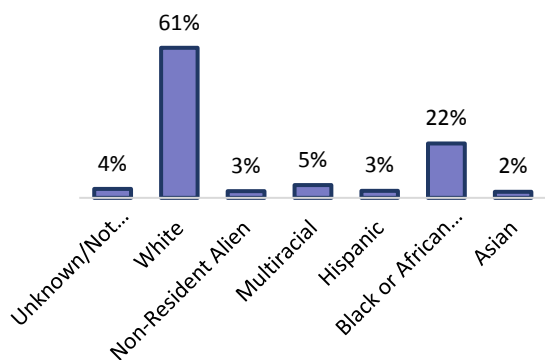

### Traditional Undergraduate

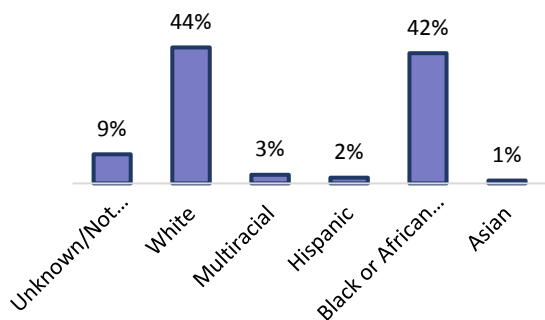

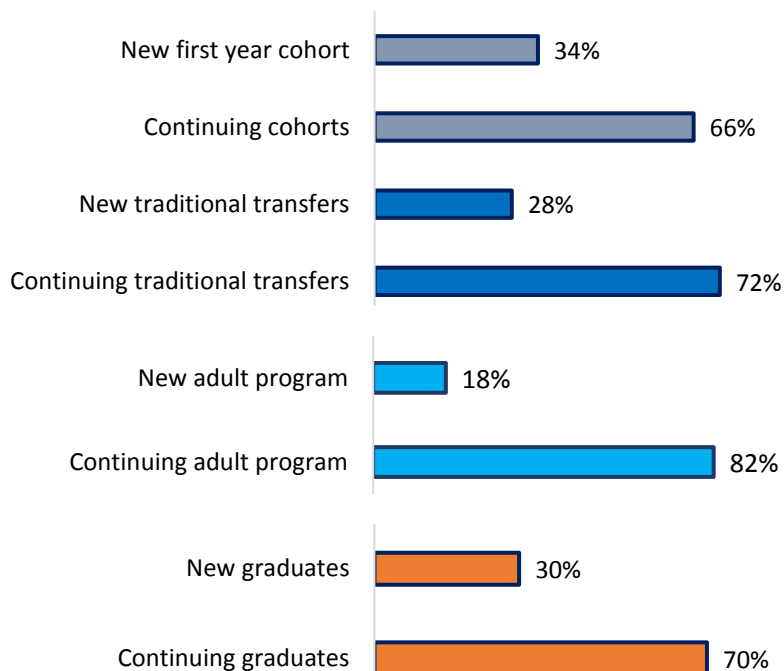
### Race/Ethnicity - Traditional UG



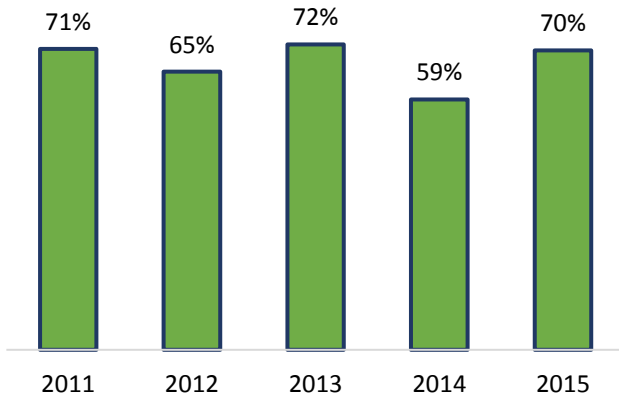
### Race/Ethnicity - Adult UG Program



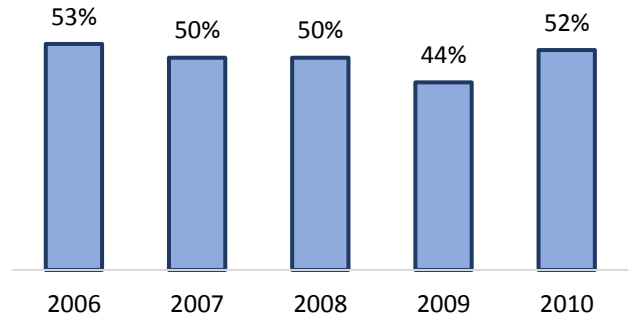
### Degree-seeking Population



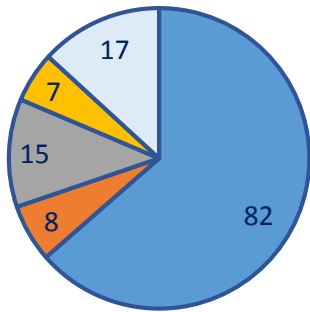
### Retention to Second Year, First Year Students



### Trend of Graduation Rate, First Year Students

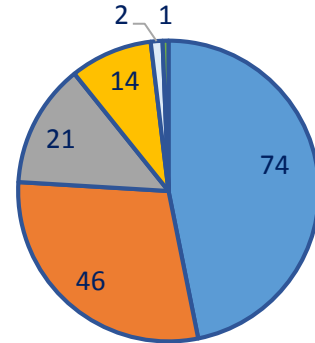


### Top Five Bachelor's Degrees - 2016
