2019-2020 Methodology

The Office of Institutional Research administered the information as follows:

- Dataset of undergraduate completers is populated with post-graduation outcomes by faculty, plus
- Survey to undergraduate completers in 2018 administered by the College's Office of Institutional Research in July 2019. Email addresses are from the Ursuline system and the College alumni office. Undergraduate response: 19 of 162 (11.72%); Graduate response: 11 of 172 (6.4%), plus
- Inquiry to the National Student Clearinghouse for subsequent education (no additional information was ascertained)

2019-2020 Results

Types of employment received by Ursuline graduates: full-time and part-time positions in the medical field, education, private businesses, government, and not-for-profit organizations.

Types of continuing/professional education pursued by Ursuline graduates: certificate program, internship, professional licensure, master's, law degree and doctorate programs in various fields including counseling and art therapy, business, historic preservation, library science, medicine, nursing, and theology.
