## **Application Requirements**

- · Application & essay
- · Official transcripts from all institutions attended
  - For international transcripts:
    - Official translations and evaluations of all transcripts or educational credentials via the World Education Services, Educational Credential Evaluators or Global Credential Evaluators
    - Demonstration of a high-level of competence in the use of the English language (TOEFL, IELTS, English3
      or the Duolingo English Test)
- Two recommendations:
  - One recommendation from applicant's immediate supervisor
  - One recommendation from a professional colleague
  - Optional: One recommendation from an academic faculty
- · Interview with Admission Committee

## **Academic Requirements**

- · A baccalaureate or graduate degree in nursing from an accredited university
- Minimum GPA of 3.0 based on a 4.0 scale from the baccalaureate/graduate degree-granting institution
- The following required courses must be within 10 years with a GPA 3.2 or greater: Chemistry, Statistics, and Anatomy & Physiology.

## **Professional Requirements**

- Current unencumbered RN license within one of the 50 states or U.S. Territories
- Minimum of one year of full-time critical care experience as a registered nurse
- · Documentation of a shadow day with a CRNA
- Current certification in Advanced Cardiovascular Life Support (ACLS)
- Current certification in Pediatric Advanced Life Support (PALS)
- · Critical Care Registered Nurse (CCRN) certification
- A criminal history background check and urine drug screen
