## **Application Requirements**

- Application & essay
- Application fee
- Official transcripts from all institutions attended
  - For international transcripts:
    - Official translations and evaluations of all transcripts or educational credentials via the World Education Services, Educational Credential Evaluators or Global Credential Evaluators
    - Demonstration of a high-level of competence in the use of the English language (TOEFL, IELTS, English3
      or the Duolingo English Test)
- Two recommendations
  - One recommendation from applicant's immediate supervisor
  - One recommendation from a professional colleague
  - Optional: One recommendation from an academic faculty
- Resume or CV
- · Interview with Admission Committee

## **Academic Requirements**

- · A baccalaureate or graduate degree in nursing from a regionally accredited college or university
- Minimum cumulative GPA of 3.0 based on a 4.0 scale, based on the combined academic record from all colleges and universities attended.
- Minimum overall prerequisite GPA of 3.2, calculated from all coursework completed in Chemistry, Statistics and Anatomy & Physiology (excluding separate laboratory courses). At least one course from each of these categories must have been completed within 10 years of the application deadline.

## **Professional Requirements**

- · Current unencumbered RN license within one of the 50 states or U.S. Territories
- Current Critical Care Registered Nurse (CCRN) certification
- Minimum of one year of full-time critical care experience as a registered nurse
- · Documentation of an observation day with a CRNA within the past two years
