You must complete and sign this worksheet, attach any required documents, and submit the form and other required documents to the Ursuline College Office of Financial Aid. We may ask for additional information after this has been submitted. If you have questions about verification, contact us as soon as possible so that your financial aid will not be delayed.

VERIFICATION OF IDENTITY

Option 1 - To Be Signed at the Institution

The student must appear in person at the Ursuline College Student Service Center or Financial Aid Office to verify their identity by presenting an unexpired valid government-issued photo identification (ID), such as, but not limited to, a driver's license, other state-issued ID, or passport. The institution will maintain a copy of the student's photo ID that is annotated by the institution with the date it was received and reviewed, and the name of the official at the institution authorized to collect the student's ID.

Option 2 - To Be Signed with a Notary

If the student is unable to appear in person at Ursuline College to verify his or her identity, the student must provide:

- A copy of the unexpired valid government-issued photo identification (ID) that is acknowledged in the notary statement on the back of this form, such as, but not limited to a driver's license, other state-issued ID, or passport.

Option 3 – Video call with Authorized Ursuline Personnel

If the student is unable to appear in person at Ursuline College to verify his or her identity, the student may appear on a video call and present the acceptable identification to an authorized individual from Ursuline's financial aid office.

- A copy of the unexpired valid government-issued photo identification (ID), such as, but not limited to a driver's license, other state-issued ID, or passport; must be made at time of video call.
