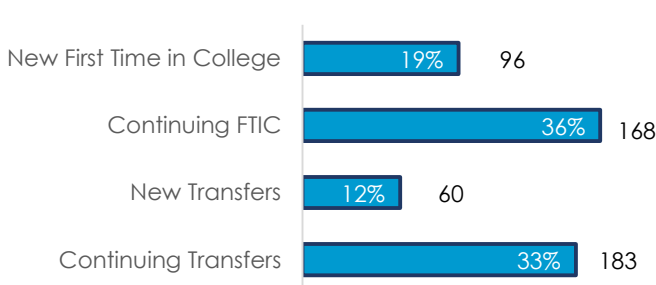

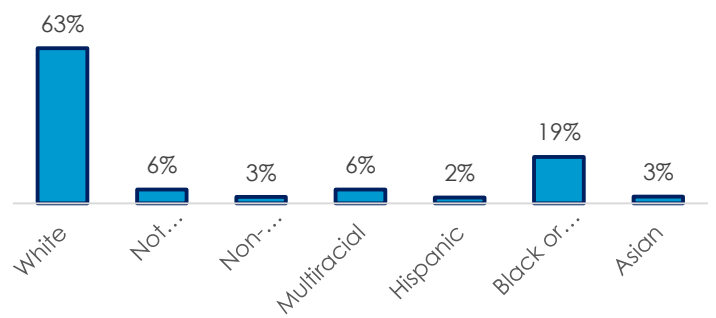

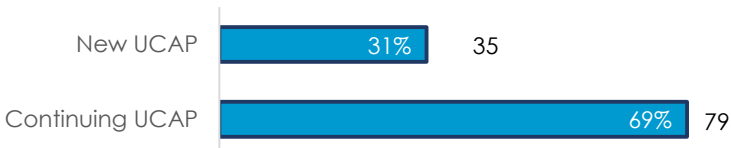
### New & Continuing Undergraduate, N=507



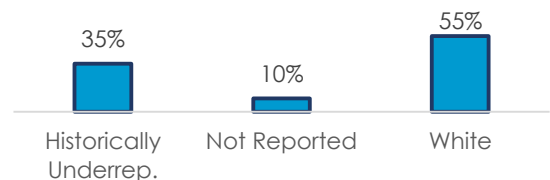
### Traditional UG Race/Ethnicity, N=507



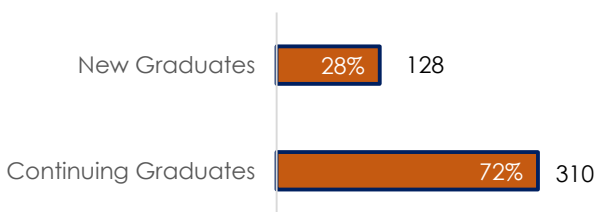
### UCAP - Adult Undergraduate Program, N=114



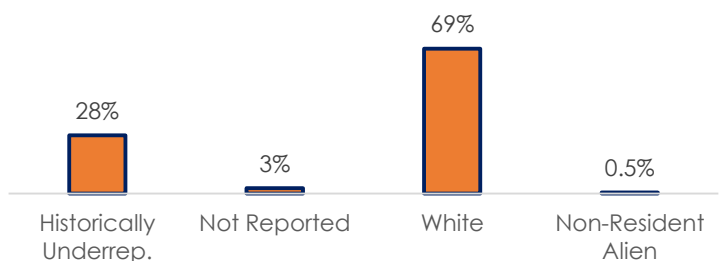
### UCAP Race/Ethnicity, N=114

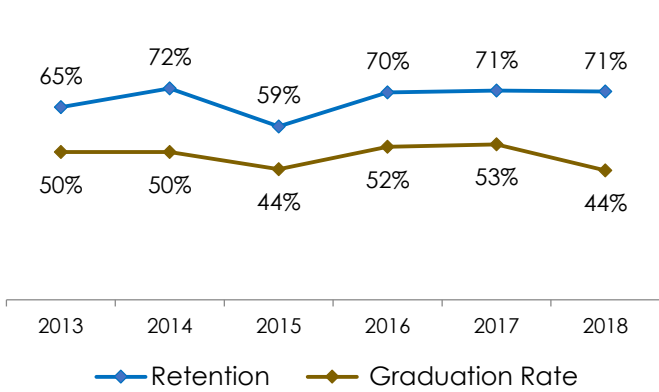


### Graduate Race/Ethnicity, N=438

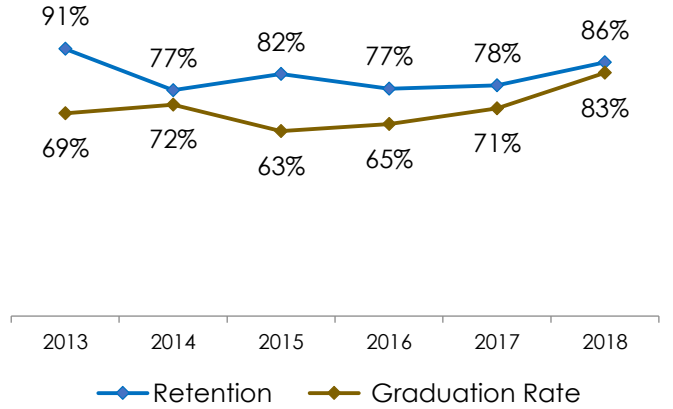

## First-time, Full-time Retention & Graduation



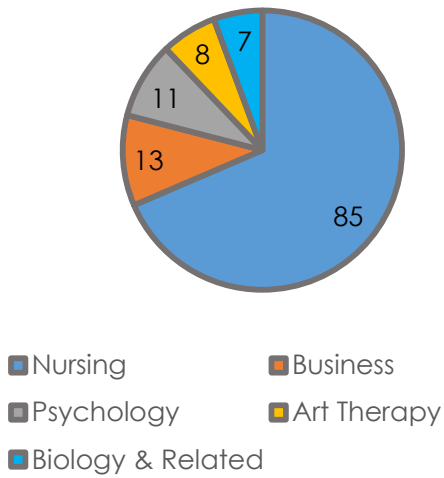
## Transfer Retention & Graduation\*



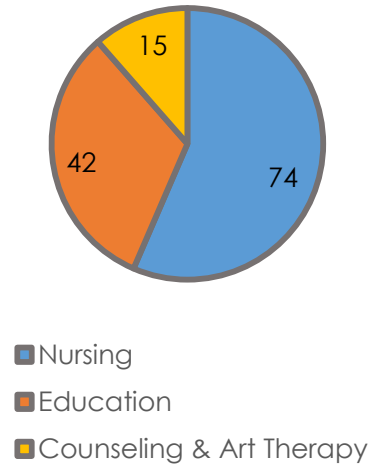

## Top Five Bachelor's Degrees, Number



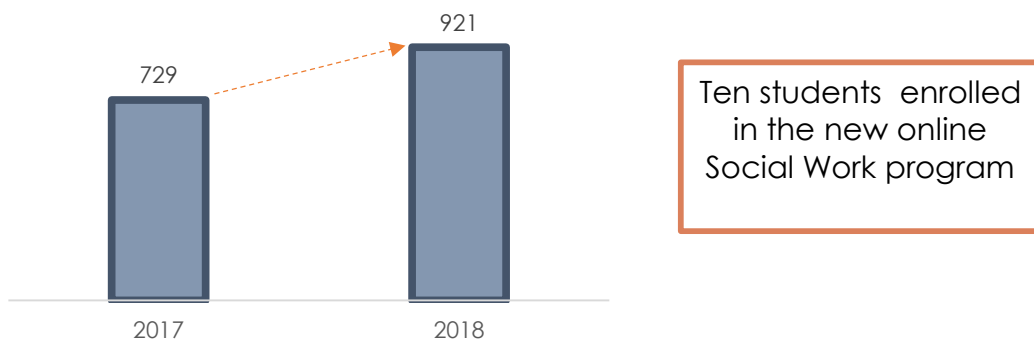
## Top Three Graduate Degrees Awarded
