

Housing Scholarship Application

Requirements

The scholarship is renewable up to three years for one room within a Smith Hall suite. The scholarship covers the cost of housing only (not a meal plan).

To be considered, students must:

- Live more than 50 miles from the Ursuline College campus.
- Admitted and enrolled in the Counseling & Art Therapy or Historic Preservation programs.
- Must have completed the Free Application for Federal Student Aid (FAFSA) on file in the financial aid office.

Applications are due **July 1 for fall semester and November 15 for spring semester**. Incomplete or late applications will not be accepted. Applications should be submitted to Jo Mann in the School of Graduate and Professional Studies in Mullen #302 or emailed to jmann@ursuline.edu.
