NOTE on compliance: To maintain compliance with federal requirements regarding maintaining the confidentiality of student personal information e.g. the above income categories this report omits the following information due to small counts:

- there is one additional student in the cohort that is not reported here but who has been excluded from the cohort graduation rate because they left Ursuline for one of the following reasons: to serve in the Armed Forces, to serve on official church missions or with a federal foreign aid service, or became deceased or totally and permanently disabled.
- Four and five-year graduation rates by the above income categories (Items B through F).
