**New OBN regulations now require graduates to take the NCLEX within 6 months of graduation, or not be counted in the school's pass rate tabulation. Of the failures, 60% of new graduates took the NCLEX more than 8 months after graduation. Therefore the adjusted exam pass rate calculated by the OBN is 88%*.
