To the contrary, pessimistic views of the present and the future take the form of dystopia – dystopias depict or foretell a world of nightmares, a world without hope. There are others who feel that we already live in a science fictionalized society controlled by codes, computers, and cyborgs. This class will use classic and recent texts that embody utopia or dystopia or science fiction, sometimes all three in one stroke. Major assignment for the course expects students to create their own utopia, to turn their fantasy of an ideal world into reality. Course runs Jan. 11-May 7, 2021.
