At least 50% of the students major must be completed at Ursuline. All Ursuline Core requirements, general requirements, and all requirements for the major must be completed along with a cumulative grade point of average of at least 2.0 for graduation. Students deficient in total credits, residency requirements, or in minimum cumulative grade point average must take additional elective credits to meet the minimum requirements.
